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UCL Careers Extra

- Enhanced careers support for UCL undergraduates from under-represented groups.
- Eligible students opt in.
- Approximately 1500 students (around 1250 current).

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Why the Champions?

- Aim of collaboration and co-creation.
- Importance of lived experience – but every experience is individual.
- Inspired by others (St Mary's Be SMART, Lancaster GROW Your Future).
- Careers Extra students wanting to give back.

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Champion role

- Five steering groups per year + option of project work.
- First team recruited March 2021.
- Outputs – initiating buddy scheme, alumni network, student society connections, social media, resources.
