## Academy chain – Strategic Partnership

- 5 schools all in south of county with few other resources
- Introduced 6<sup>th</sup> form
- 50% of 6<sup>th</sup> formers come to Lincoln
- Senior staff on governing bodies work with local employers
- WP activities and research projects
- Travel time a challenge
