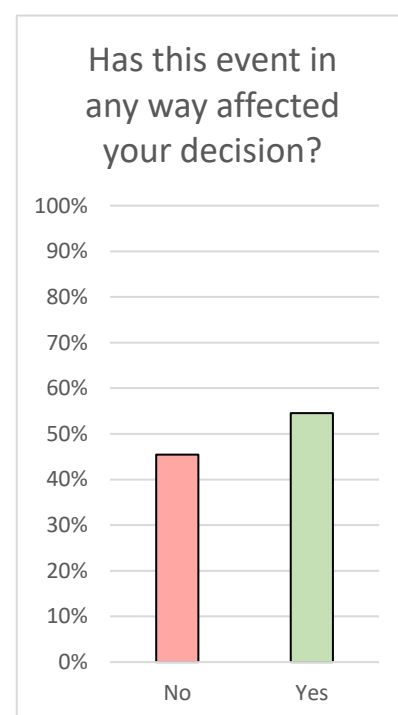
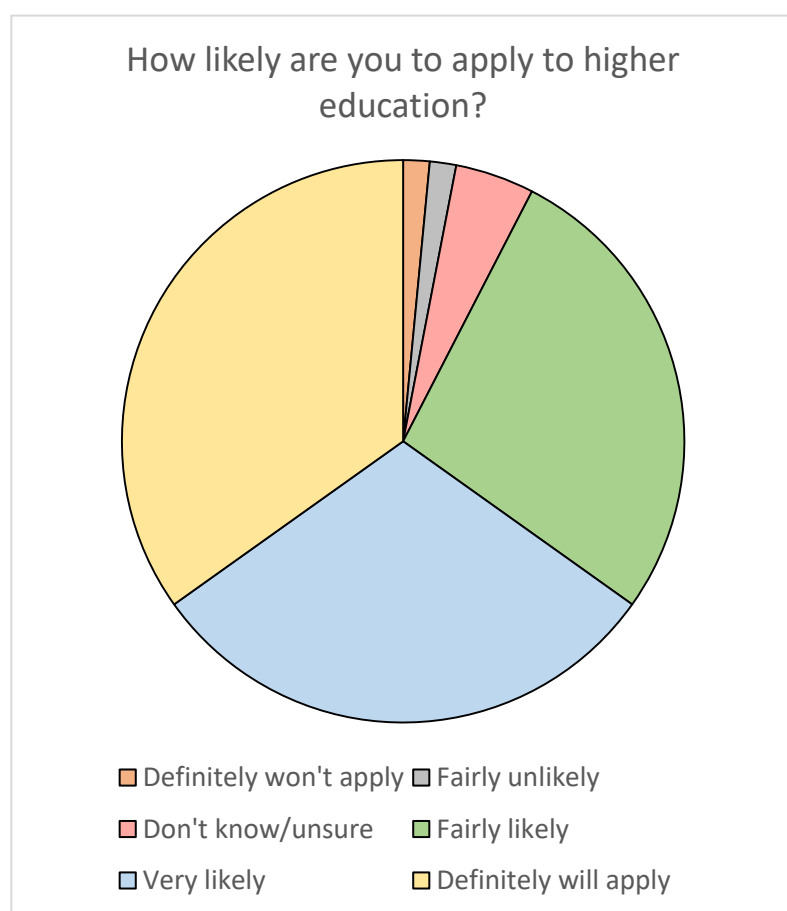


Mock Open Day Evaluation (Students)

On the 28th March 2018, NCOP Higher York arranged a Mock Open Day at the University of York. The aim of the event was to give current Year 11/Year 12 students a taste of what a College/University open day is like.

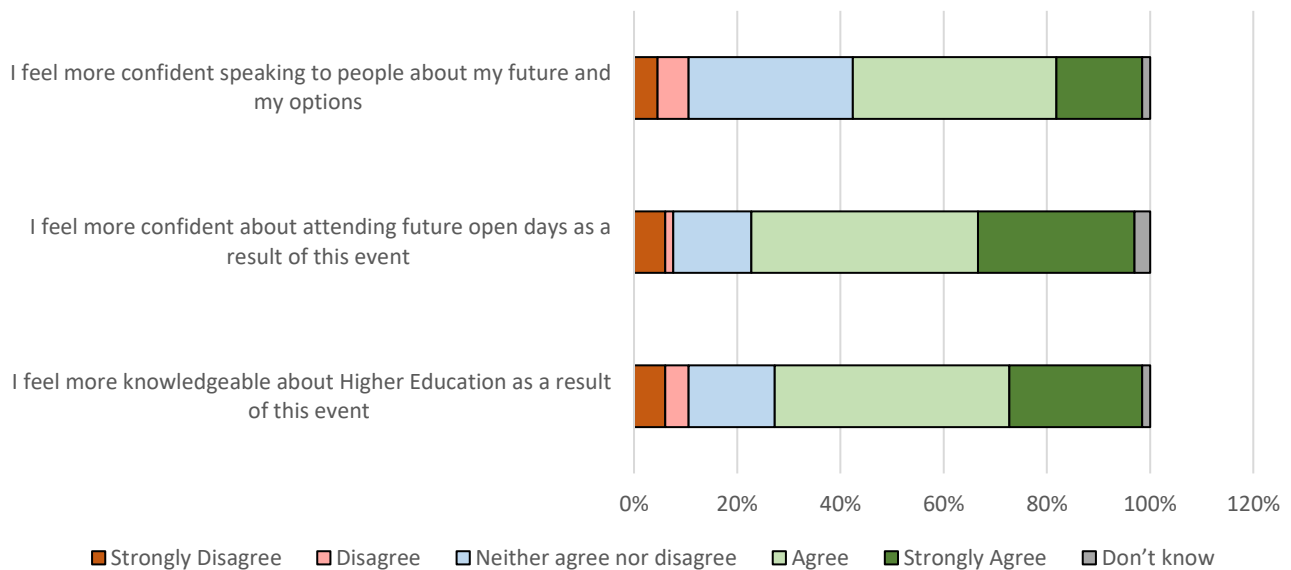
The evaluation was carried out at the end of the event, this report will summarise the main findings.

The overwhelming majority of respondents indicated that they have an inclination to apply to university, with just over half of these stating that they were influenced by the Mock Open Day.



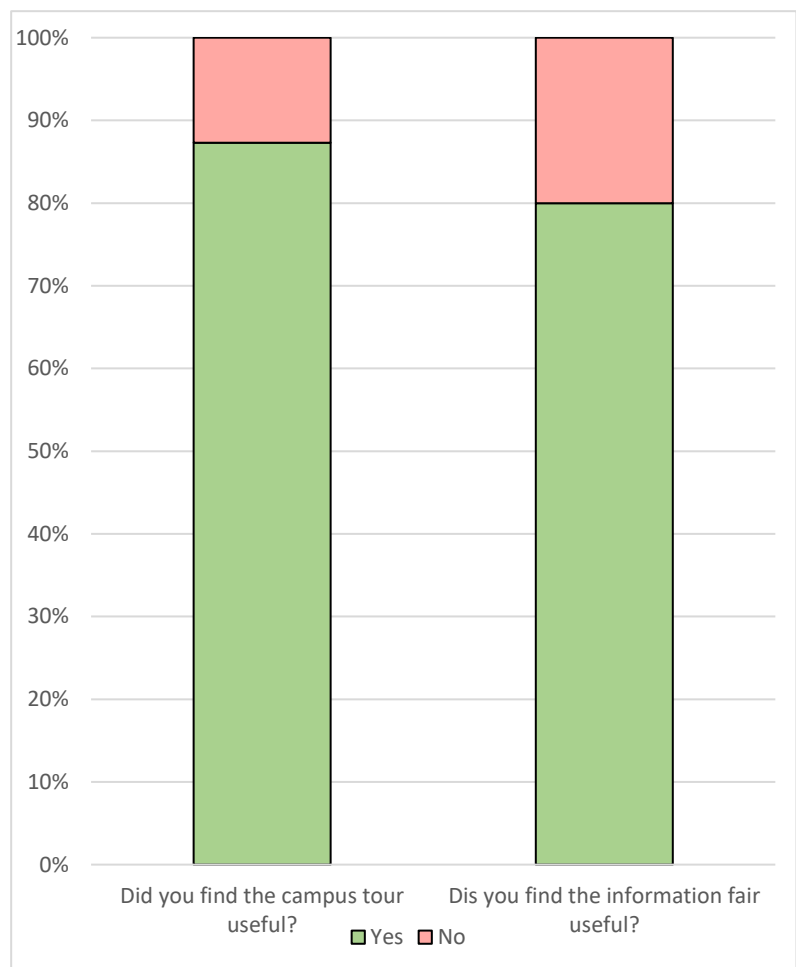
The evaluation also suggests that the event has increased the students' confidence with regards to attending future open days, speaking to people about their future options and their knowledge of higher education.

How much do you agree with the following statements?

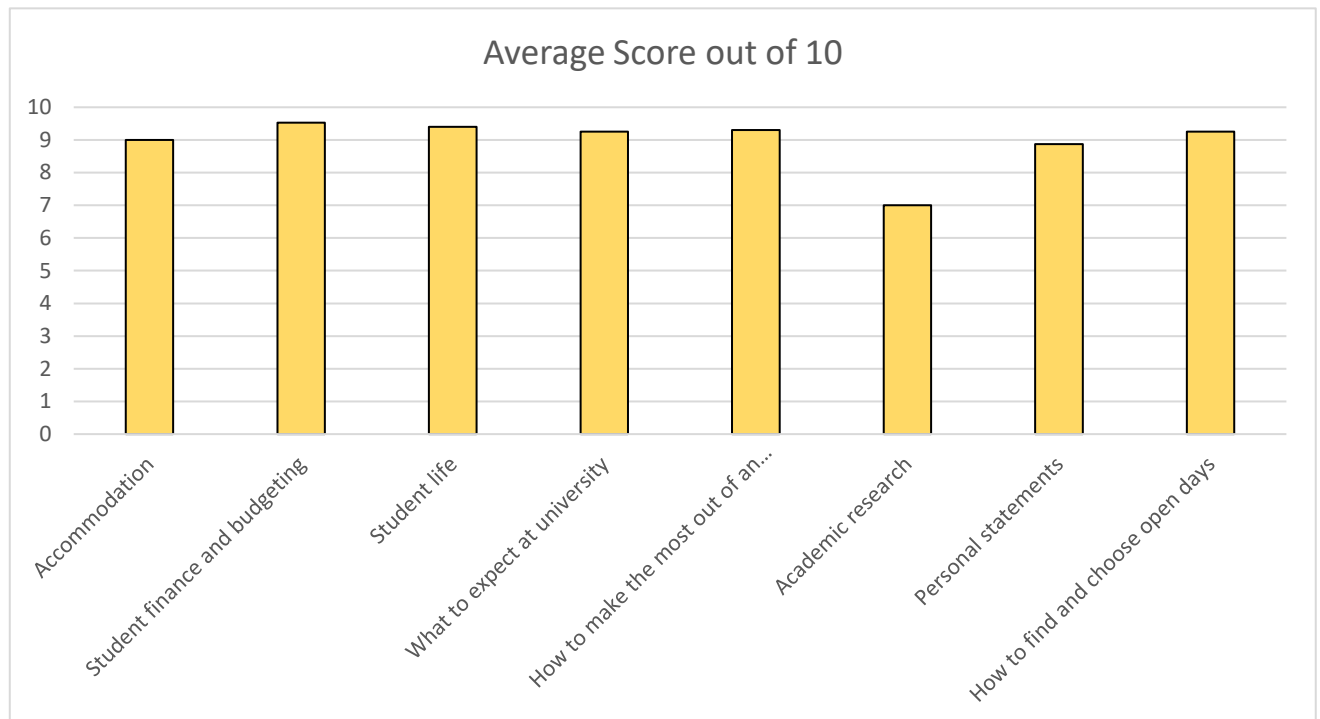

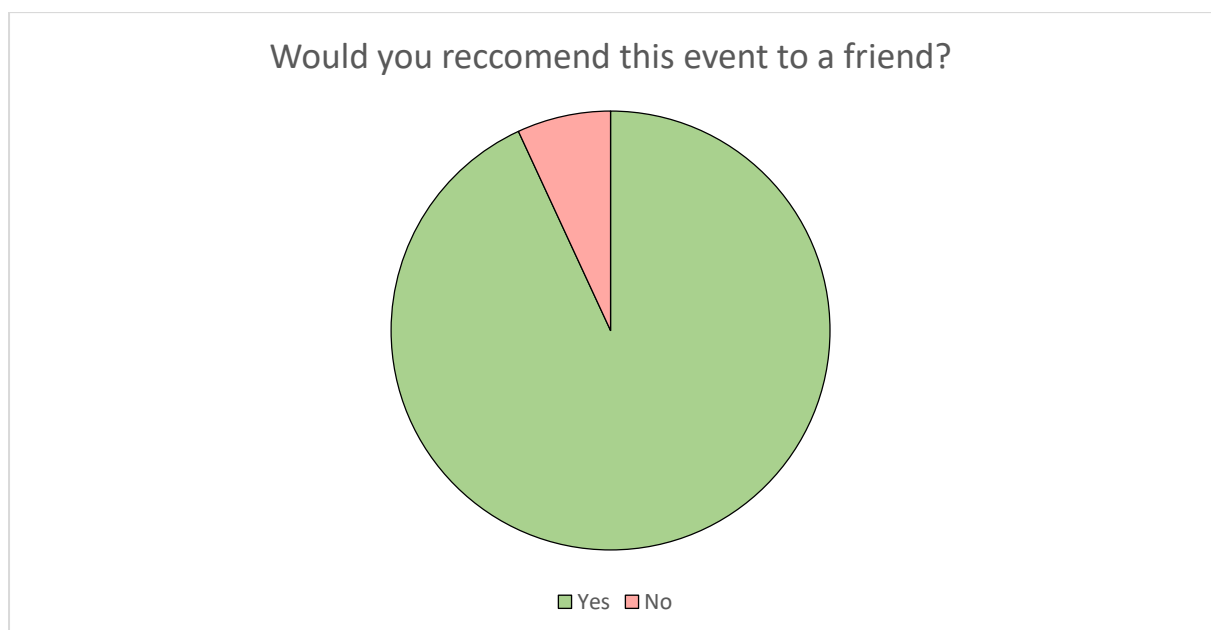

In addition to the fair and the tour, a number of talks were also offered to the students. Respondents to the evaluation rated their usefulness below:

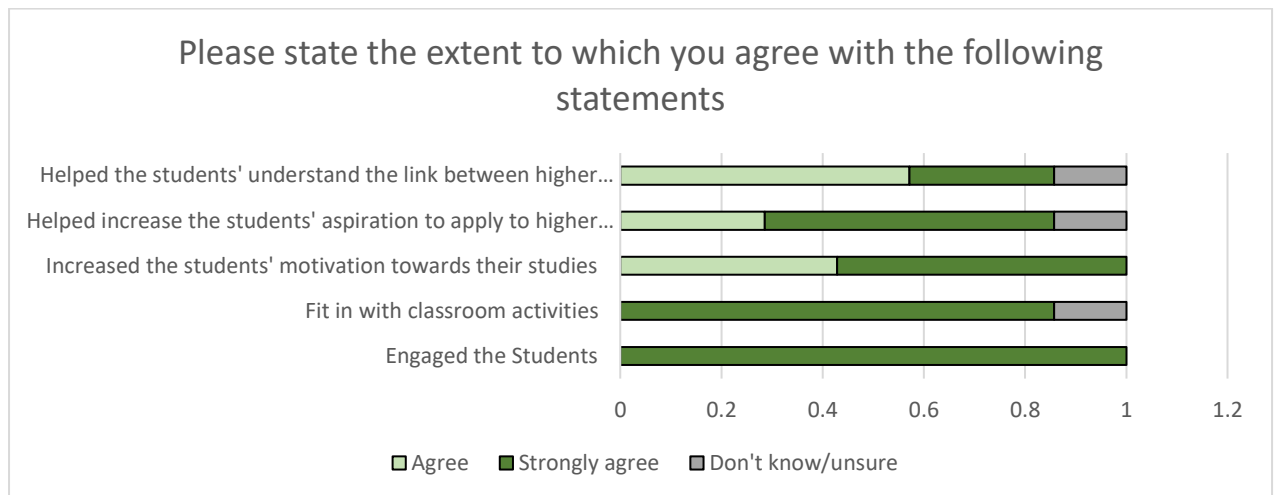


Finally, when asked if they would recommend this event to a friend, the overwhelming majority (93%) stated that they would.



Mock Open Day Evaluation (Teachers)

In addition to the student evaluation, the teachers were also provided with feedback forms. Seven teachers completed the evaluation, and as can be seen below, all teachers strongly agreed that the day had engaged their students.



The teachers were also asked to rate the talks in terms of usefulness. They rated the talks 9.3 out of 10.
