SMILES is a peer mentoring project that supports student success and transitions in a widening participation university. SMILES is funded through an OfS access and participation fund. - Sustained retention and progression framework




Pre-enrolment mentoring to aid transition and access to HE


- Full time young people

- Reduce progression gap into employment




